## SAPSASA News

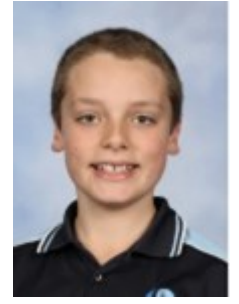
