MUSIC

We are proud to offer a classroom music program in line with the Australian Curriculum. This program is complemented by instrumental music tuition, a school band and school choir. Our music program is a highlight program in our school.

MUSIC PROGRAM

Littlehampton has an alive, vibrant music program that is valued and embraced by the school community. The music program at Littlehampton is a developmental program which enables students to develop their music skills in reading, writing and creating music in an enjoyable and fulfilling way.

Classroom Music

All classes from Reception to year 6 have lessons with a specialist music teacher each week. Students from Reception to year 2 have two lessons per week and students from year 3 to year 6 have one lesson each week.

During these lessons students develop their musical skills through singing, speaking, moving, dance, listening, playing instruments, improvising, composing and performing. Students will use a variety of classroom instruments during lessons.

Instrumental Music

Students can learn a musical Instrument individually from a private music tutor or in a group with a department teacher. These lessons are held during school time.

Parents pay the private tutor for their tuition. Instruments can be hired in negotiation with the private tutor or department teacher, or through a music hire company.

Currently private tuition is offered for keyboard and guitar. The department teacher teaches a variety of brass and woodwind instruments. Options will be discussed with the student when they apply.

Choir

Even though this is not accurate for this year because of COVID19 I'd keep this paragraph apart from changing the name of the choir from "school choir" to "Senior choir" but add this:-

Students in years 3 and 4 have an opportunity to join our Junior choir. This choir gives students their first experience at choral singing and gives them a good grounding in choral singing before they join our more challenging 2 part senior choir.

Music Showcase

All classes perform in the Music Showcase which is held over two nights every alternate year. This is a wonderful evening embraced by the whole school community and showcases music at Littlehampton school.
