

UNIFORM POLICY & DRESS CODE

PURPOSE: The purpose of a school uniform and dress code is to:

- Promote a sense of belonging, community and pride within the student community.
- Encourage appropriate, functional & comfortable clothing for school activities.
- Ensure health & safety issues are appropriately managed (sun smart/ physical education).
- Be smart and distinctive, enhancing the school's image within the wider community.
- Establish equality among students and reduce peer pressure.

UNIFORM: All school logos are embroidered at Work Locker

Tops

- Pale blue or navy short or long sleeve polo shirt (logo required)
- Polar fleece part zip jumper or full zip jacket without hood (logo required)
 - note previous windcheater embroidered with "Littlehampton" is still acceptable
- Pale blue, navy or white skivvy to wear under the long sleeve polo shirt, winter dress and with winter skirt (logo not required)
- Pale blue, navy or white long sleeve round neck top to wear under the short sleeve polo t-shirt (logo not required)
- Navy zip-up rain jacket (logo not required)
- Navy puffer or polar fleece vest (logo optional)
- Year 6 Seniors' polo top, navy with blue and white trim (logo required)
- Year 6 Seniors' windcheater (logo required)

Pants/Shorts/Skorts/Skirts/Dresses

- Plain full-length navy or dark grey trousers or navy or dark grey track pants (logo not required)
- Plain navy tights or stockings, to be worn under dresses, skirts or skorts (logo not required)
- Plain navy leggings (logo not required)
- Plain navy or dark grey shorts, knee-length (logo not required)
- Plain navy 'skort' or skirt (halfway above knee) (logo not required)
- Summer check school dress (halfway above knee) (logo not required)
- Winter check pinafore or skirt (halfway above knee) (logo not required)

Accessories

- Plain navy gloves
- Plain navy beanie (logo optional)
- Plain scarves in navy, pale blue or white (logo optional)
- Plain navy broad brim or legionnaires hat (logo required)

Shoes

All school footwear needs to be sturdy and suitable for fitness and sport every day:

- Lace-up or velcro sport sneakers predominately in navy, black, or white
- Black or navy blue school shoes
- Black or navy blue sturdy school sandals
- No flat-bottomed skate shoes, canvas shoes, or lightweight dress shoes or sandals please
- Plain navy, grey, black or white socks



Hair/Makeup/Jewellery

- Plain hair accessories (head bands, scrunchies, ribbons, clips and hair ties) in navy, pale blue, white, school uniform fabric or hair tone
- Makeup is not permitted
- Nail polish is not permitted
- The following jewellery items are acceptable:
 - Medical bracelets
 - Plain earrings in navy, pale blue, white, silver or gold
 - Fitness trackers
 - Watches (smart watches not permitted)

School Bags

- School bags with the school logo can be purchased from Work Locker, but are not mandatory.

Please note

- All school uniforms can be purchased from Work Locker, or from a retailer and taken to Work Locker for embroidery.
- 'Plain' means no patterns, stripes, logo, decoration, or branding (school logo permitted).
- Please label all items carefully. Clothing with name labels will be returned to the relevant classroom. Unlabelled items will remain in lost property for a term and will then be sold through the second-hand uniform shop run by the Parents and Friends committee.

Non-compliance

It is expected that all students will comply with the uniform and dress code. The Principal may exempt students upon written request from a parent or caregiver on cultural, medical or religious grounds.

Non-compliance will be communicated firstly to parents/caregivers via email. School staff will not raise issues directly with students, other than for Work Health and Safety issues, or presentation. Any ongoing issues of non-compliance will be managed by the Principal, in consultation with, the parent(s)/caregiver(s).
